## PLEASE READ COMPLETELY

- THE DRIVEWAY SPEED LIMIT IS 15MPH. Please take care while when driving down the driveway and in the parking lot. There are children and animals roaming and you never know when they cross the driveway.
- NO DOGS ALLOWED ON THE PREMESIS.
- **DO NOT FEED THE HORSES**. Some of the horses have allergies to certain foods and others get overly excited with the wrestling sound of treat bags. Many also get impatient waiting for food and can get aggressive.
- DO NOT ENTER THE INDOOR UNLESS IT IS TO MOUNT A HORSE (ie; no walking through the ring to speak to an instructor or cut across to another aisle). When entering the ring, announce your arrival to warn approaching riders. Calling out "DOOR" is the most common way.
- SPECTATORS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN ANY OF THE RIDING ARENAS for both your safety and the safety of the horses and riders in the arenas. There are viewing rooms for spectators. People passing through the ring or congregating in the corners are disruptive to the horses, riders and instructors.
- **DO NOT GIVE UNSOLICITED INSTRUCTION from the sidelines**. If there is a lesson in progress, the instructor should be the only person giving instructions. It is difficult enough without added confusion from untrained spectators.
- CHILDREN NEED TO BE WATCHED AT ALL TIMES. Young children running around are likely to spook horses and cause unnecessary falls. Please keep children close and quiet.
- Cell phones should NOT be used in any manner while on horseback.
- Cooling off or walking should be done **off** the rail. You should never pass another rider without fair warning.
- All riding is done in the same direction as the lesson. Absolutely no jumping allowed in the same ring as a beginner lesson in progress. Please consider the ability level of the students and if unsure, ask the instructor.
- There is no hand walking (unless medically necessary), lunging and/or horse rolling allowed while lessons are in progress.
- Free rides, rentals and leased horses do not include the option of rider changes. NO jumping allowed on free rides, rentals or lease rides.
- Check with the barn staff if outside riding is allowed and recommended in icy/snowy conditions.
- Pick up after your horse in the aisle. Manure should never be left in the aisle and/or driveway.
- Let's all take pride and care for our barn, equipment and horses. Throw away all trash (even if it's not your own) and please put back all tack, grooming tools and such in their right place.
- We are not responsible for any items left behind.
